

## The Cavalier Daily Summer Internship Application

The Cavalier Daily Summer Internship is a paid program that aims to provide students interested in journalism with on-the-ground newsroom experience. Interns will be trained to report across both print and digital platforms, with a particular emphasis on multimedia news production, and will be tasked with covering University and Charlottesville news for The Cavalier Daily during the summer months. The internship will consist of **one summer editor, two reporters, and one part-time production staffer** who will work to produce regular online content as well as two summer publications.

Interns selected for the Cavalier Daily Summer Internship program will spend 8 weeks in Charlottesville. The program will run during Session II and Session III of the 2016 Summer Term (Sunday, June 12 - Friday, August 5). Interns must be in Charlottesville for the duration of the internship and will receive a stipend for their work.
