In the fall of 2017 we will continue pre-production on the film and begin principle photography.

Intern responsibilities will include:

Story research
Archival research and acquisition
Video research of examples of visual styles and techniques
Location scouting and permissions
Contact with interviewees
Production assistance on location
Editorial assistance (Premiere)
Social media (may not begin in fall 2017)

Please note that we will suit the internship to the skills and learning interests of qualified applicants. Production experience is a plus but not necessary.

Some work can be done from Grounds but it is a plus if you have transportation to our office space (right behind Circa and Cville Coffee off the 250 bypass at McIntire Road). We expect interns to spend 10 to 15 hours a week on the project.

We anticipate the opportunity for interns to stay involved with the production until its completion in the fall of 2018. Third year students are therefore encouraged to apply.

Internships can be for course credit or solely for learning purposes.
