

# The VQR Internship Program



Do you want to intern at the magazine that has won more National Magazine Awards in the last decade than any other literary quarterly in the nation?

Established at the University of Virginia in 1925, VQR has published fiction, poetry, and criticism from more than 15 Nobel Laureates, as well as the latest works from the best emerging writers and photojournalists. It has a global online readership of nearly 650,000 people in 206 countries and an international print circulation.

The internship program will focus on:

- magazine production
- proofreading skills
- editorial skills and judgment
- marketing and audience engagement
- manuscript evaluation

Past interns have gone on to staff positions at Dropbox, Oracle, the *New York Times*, and Algonquin Books, and have written for *Granta*, *Outside*, *Bloomberg Businessweek*, and other publications.

A commitment of at least 10 hours per week is required, for a minimum of two months. Start and end dates are flexible, with mid-semester and summer start dates available. We are located on the grounds of the Boar's Head in Charlottesville, with free parking available on-site.
